

# How far can you go in an LNG truck?

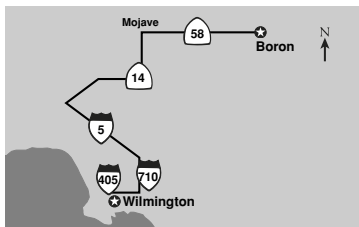

## How about to Boron and back — with fuel to spare?

Recently, a trucking firm in Southern California conducted a test of the new Kenworth LNG tractor dead-heading from Carson CA to Boron CA and returning with a loaded container. The firm is a major regional trucking operator serving Southern California with a fleet of more than 1,600 trucks. It has committed to adding LNG trucks to its fleet and conducted the test to determine performance parameters.

Distance roundtrip	300 miles
LNG fuel consumed	49.22 DEGs
LNG fuel economy	5.79 mpg
Anticipated fuel savings*	\$47.25
Estimated range running to empty	332 miles
Outbound (empty container) GVW	30,000 lbs
Inbound (20' container) GVW	74,000 lbs
Cruise speed	58 mph



\*Based on the average savings in 2008 of LNG over diesel of \$0.96 per gallon.
