In growing numbers across America, parking operators are working diligently to transition their diesel and gasoline-powered shuttle fleets to run on natural gas fuel.

The momentum is particularly strong in the airport sector. Mindful of high concentrations of harmful emissions in and around airports, and concerned about compliance with clean air laws, many airport operators have adopted alternative-fuel vehicle policies for their ground transport fleets.

Ranging from shuttle cutaways to full-size transit buses, approximately 4,000 airport parking shuttle vehicles are in service today around the country. Of these, hundreds are already running on clean compressed natural gas (CNG) fuel.

Why are more and more parking shuttle operators transitioning their fleets to natural gas? Because natural gas fuel is cleaner, greener, cheaper, and domestically sourced.

The Energy Information Administration (EIA/DOE) estimates that 98% of the natural gas consumed in North America is sourced in the U.S. and Canada, and supplies are projected to last over 100 years. Parking shuttles are one of the niche markets that stands to benefit most as the country shifts increasingly away from expensive imported oil. CNG consistently costs less than gasoline or diesel fuel, ranging up to \$1.50 or more less per gallon.

In addition, natural gas produces up to 30% lower greenhouse gas emissions in light-duty vehicles compared to gasoline, and up to 23% lower greenhouse gas emissions in medium to heavy-duty vehicles compared to diesel.

For parking shuttle operators, Clean Energy offers:
