## Clean Energy Partners with City of Dallas to Open Fueling Station at Love Field, Extending Area Fueling Infrastructure

The new natural gas fueling station at Dallas Love Field, first at the airport, is designed to serve the CNG-powered fleet vehicles of the City of Dallas with 24 hour/7 day access. The airport is located seven miles northwest of the downtown central business district.



Dallas has the largest light-duty CNG municipal fleet in the nation with more than 1,200 vehicles.

Over time, the station will be expanded to serve additional private and government fleet natural gas vehicles (NGVs) serving the airport.

The public-private partnership created for the project balanced the City of Dallas providing civil improvements with Clean Energy providing the equipment and services under a long-term operations and maintenance contract.

Served by Southwest Airlines and Continental Express, Love Field serves seven million passengers a year, providing a vital link in the economy of the City of Dallas and the region.
