National, State, Local Leaders Gather to Honor Town of Smithtown's Landmark Clean-Air Mandate

*— Long Island Municipality First in New York State to Convert Its
Entire Refuse Fleet from Diesel to Environmentally-Friendly Natural Gas —*

Smithtown, Long Island, NY (Sept. 19, 2006) — Clean Energy, leading U.S. provider of clean-burning natural gas fuel, and Hallahan Truck Sales, Holtsville, NY natural gas refuse truck dealer, hosted special ceremonies on Sept. 19 to salute Smithtown's commitment to ensuring a clean-air environment. Smithtown is the first municipality in New York State to convert its entire refuse fleet from diesel to environmentally-friendly natural gas power. The Township has signed a multi-year fixed-price agreement with Clean Energy to supply natural gas fuel to the trash collection fleet.

Clean Energy operates a public access natural gas fueling station in nearby Hauppauge, which, when current upgrade efforts are complete, will be the largest such facility on the East Coast. The station will provide fuel to Smithtown's contracted refuse haulers.

Special guest speakers at the Sept. 19 event included: New York Gov. George Pataki; Boone Pickens, Clean Energy founder; Town of Smithtown Supervisor Patrick Vecchio; Commissioner John J. Spano, NYS Office of General Services; and Peter Smith, President, NYS Energy Research and Development Authority.

On view for event attendees was a clean, quiet running custom-configured natural-gas powered AUTOCAR Xpeditor® WXLL refuse truck from Hallahan Truck Sales. Trucks of this type will be deployed for Smithtown trash collection duties in January 2007.

Commissioner John J. Spano, NYS Office of General Services, said, "The State's partnership with Clean Energy has been an imperative step in extending natural gas fuel availability beyond State government use, and further reducing our dependence on foreign oil. This new initiative with the Town of Smithtown is another win-win for the State, the Town, and Clean Energy."

Town of Smithtown Supervisor Vecchio commented, "I'm very gratified that so many people are expressing their support for our natural gas refuse project. We've looked at the facts and the move to alternative energy is necessary now. Natural gas fuel is cheaper than diesel fuel and the supplies are available here in North America, which reduces our dependence on foreign oil. When you add that to the environmental benefits of using natural gas instead of diesel fuel, the choice is clear."

On behalf of the Greater Long Island Clean Cities Coalition, Chairman Ronald Gulmi said, "The natural gas sanitation trucks slated for Smithtown will provide significant air quality benefits to local residents and the entire Long Island region. In the process, the Town will displace an estimated 2.5 million gallons of imported diesel fuel, an important step in reducing our dependence on foreign oil."

Catell, Chairman and CEO of KeySpan Corp., "Natural gas sanitation trucks offer the most significant economic, environmental and energy independence benefits of today's available sanitation trucks. We commend the Town of Smithtown for this action, and we will upgrade our natural gas distribution system to support Clean Energy's expanded natural gas fueling station in Hauppauge."
