The Energy Information Administration (EIA/DOE) estimates that 98% of the natural gas consumed in North America is sourced in North America, and domestic supplies are projected to last for 120 years.

Transit fleets are one of the major markets that stand to benefit significantly as the country shifts increasingly away from expensive imported oil. Natural gas costs 25% to 40% less than diesel fuel, and projections call for this favorable cost trend to extend well into the future.
