## 2025 Carl Moyer Program Vehicle Replacement

**Due:** July 1, 2025

**Program budget:** \$43.4 million

### Eligible projects:

Eligible projects include Class 4-8 >14,001 lbs. heavy-duty diesel vehicles, including drayage trucks, solid waste vehicles, and transit fleets.

### Eligible applicants:

Eligible applicants include public or private entities located in South Coast AQMD boundaries.

### How is the award amount of a Carl Moyer Program Grant determined?

- For vehicles, grants are based on the cost-effectiveness and emission benefits of the project.
- Small fleets (<20) are eligible for up to 80% of vehicle cost and large fleets (>20) up to 50%.
- Infrastructure projects are selected on a competitive basis and are not required to meet a cost-effectiveness limit.

1. No more than 80 percent of vehicle cost for fleets with 20 or less vehicles, no more than 50 percent of vehicle cost for fleets except emergency vehicles.

### General requirements:

- Project equipment must be domiciled within the South Coast Air Basin (SCAB).  
On-road vehicles must operate at least 51% of the time in the SCAB.
- Eligible vehicles must have an engine model year 2010-2019.
